Whaiora must have an assigned community mental health support worker.

Community mental health support worker must attend whakawhanaunga with the whaiora at Te Oranga Activities, 160 Woodham Road.

Community mental health support worker will support the whaiora until the whaiora and Purapura Whetu staff agree that the whaiora no longer require Community mental health support worker supervision at Te Oranga Activities.

As some classes have limited numbers of participants, please be aware the community mental health support workers are not included participants.

Te Oranga Activities and resources are provided at no cost to the whaiora.

Purapura Whetu provide morning and afternoon tea.

Given advance notice transport home may be provided for the whaiora as well. This is up to the discretion of Purapura Whetu staff.
